

## **Journeyman Practical Examination**

**The Practical Exam is working with a Master (or Master Craftsman) Beekeeper, the participant must go through a binder which has been broken down into different topics. For each, there is a diagram, photos, or labels, which the participant must be able to describe ( *verbally* ) to the person administering the exam; answering questions, stating what something is or what it is used for, or what is correct or incorrect, etc.**

**There are nine topics. The participant chooses five to be examined upon, and must pass at least 4 of the 5 that they have chosen to pass the Practical Portion of the Journeyman Exam. A jar of honey to judge will be provided if you select "Score a Jar of Honey". All other items are in the note book.**
