Journeyman Practical Examination

The Practical Exam is working with a Master (or Master Craftsman) Beekeeper, the participant must go through a binder which has been broken down into different topics. For each, there is a diagram, photos, or labels, which the participant must be able to describe (*verbally*) to the person administering the exam; answering questions, stating what something is or what it is used for, or what is correct or incorrect, etc.

There are nine topics. The participant chooses five to be examined upon, and must pass at least 4 of the 5 that they have chosen to pass the Practical Portion of the Journeyman Exam. A jar of honey to judge will be provided it you select "Score a Jar of Honey". All other items are in the note book.
