Three Master Beekeepers, one must be a member of the MBP, will administer this exam. Candidate must be passed by two of the three examiners to have successfully completed this field exam. The exam will be conducted at an apiary of the MBP's choosing, specifically, not the candidates apiary. Candidate must wear appropriate PPE, gloves are optional. Candidate must supply their own tools including but not limited to a new or sterilized hive tool, smoker, and fuel. Smoker must remain lit during entirety of exam. Exam will be terminated if the smoker goes out. No re-light is permitted. This field exam shall be completed within 40 minutes. Examiners will dismiss candidate at the conclusion of the exam. Candidate will be notified of their results with-in one week.**
